The Orange County Sheriff Department is a large, multi-faceted law enforcement agency composed of approximately 4,000 staff members and more than 800 reserve personnel.

The core services the Department provides include: Public protection, including patrol of land, harbors and coastline, homeland security, court and airport security, and emergency communications; jail operations; technical services including investigations, coroner services, forensics, emergency management and centralized Countywide communications systems; and administrative and support services.
